



This Month's Developer's Poll

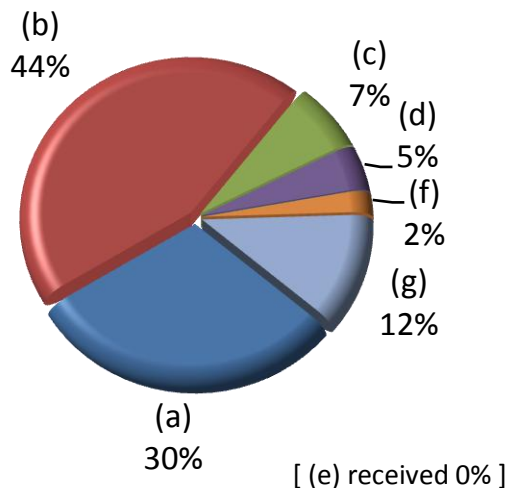
